

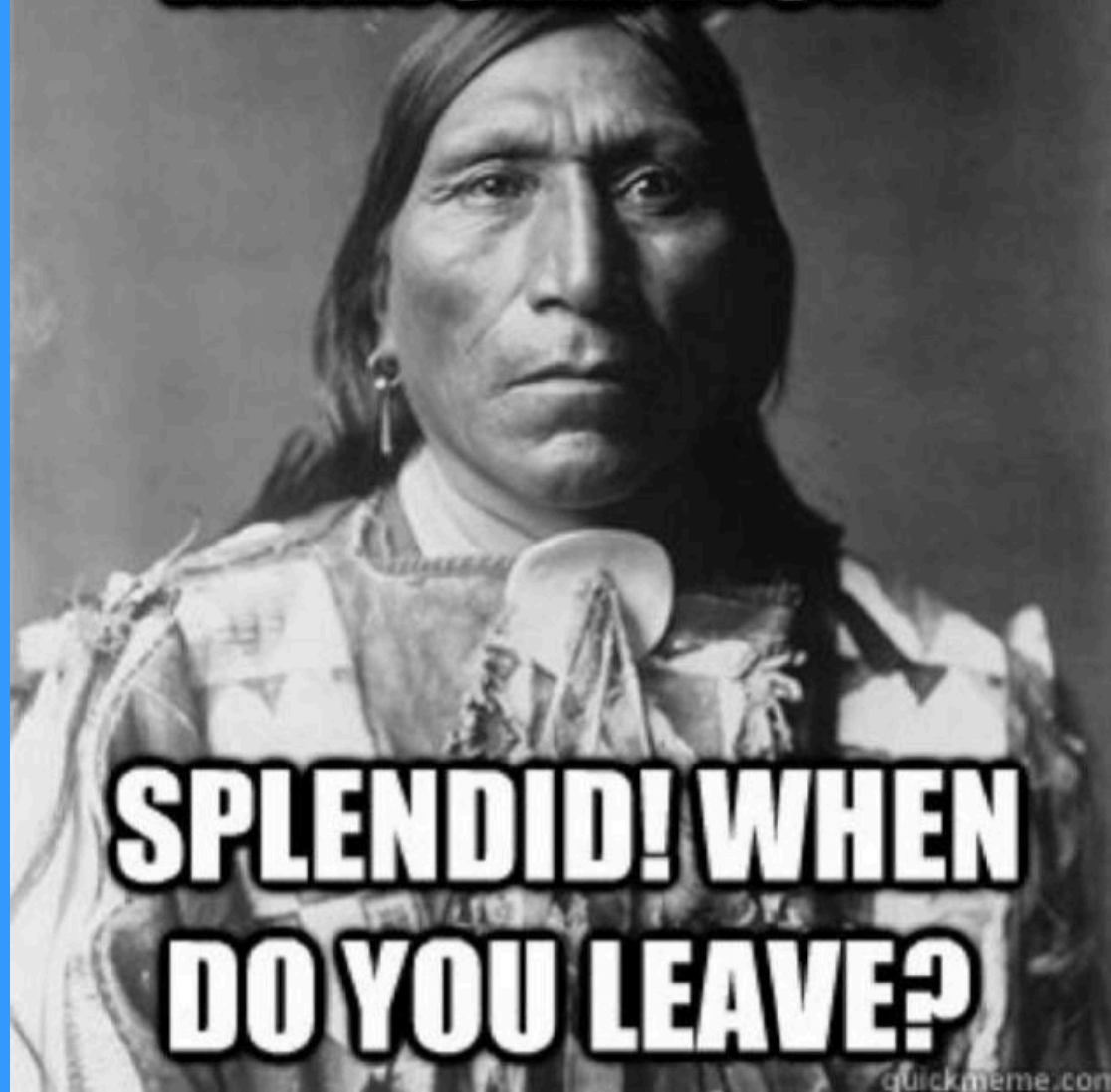

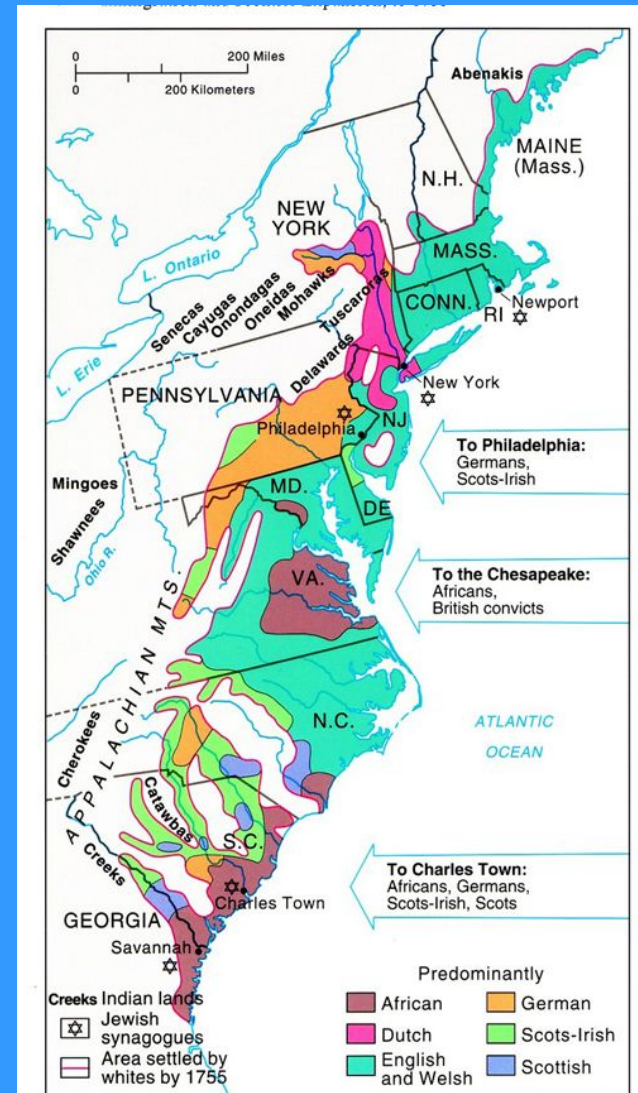

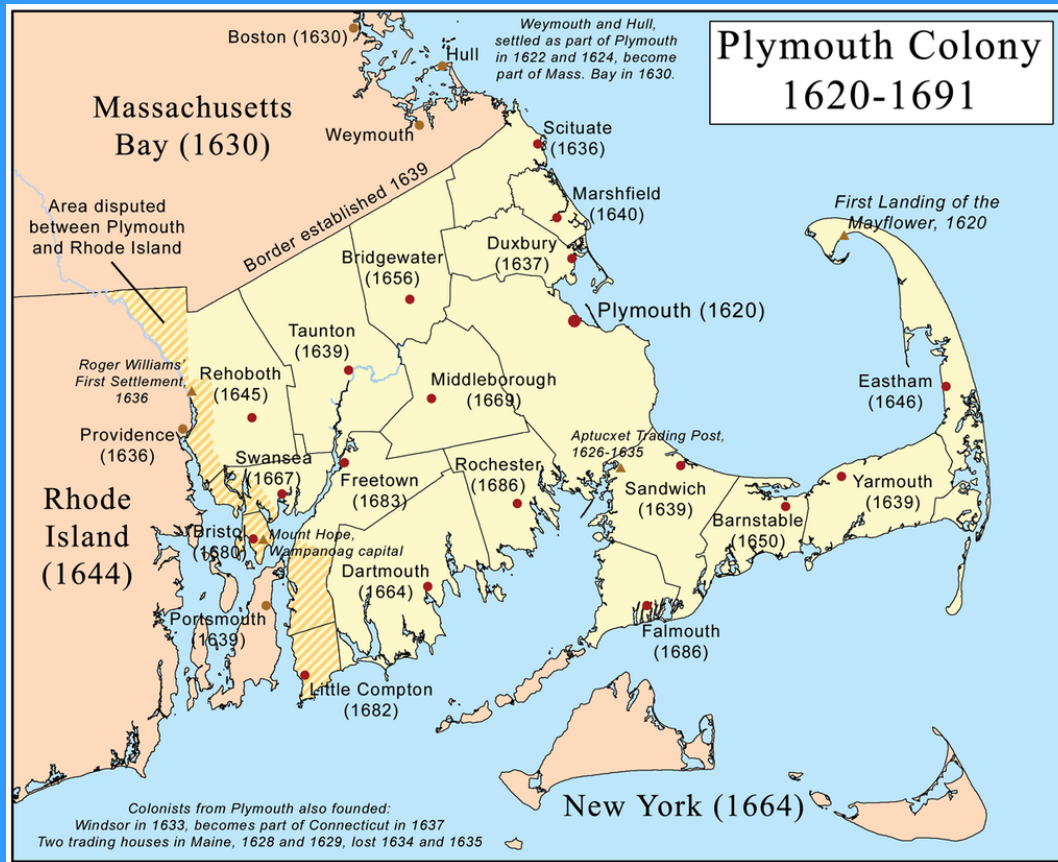

Plymouth Colony



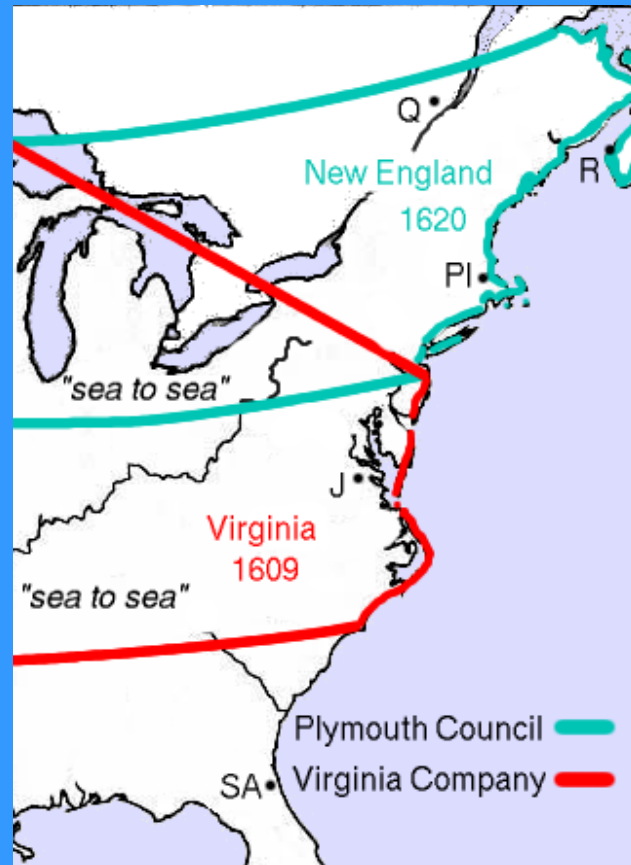

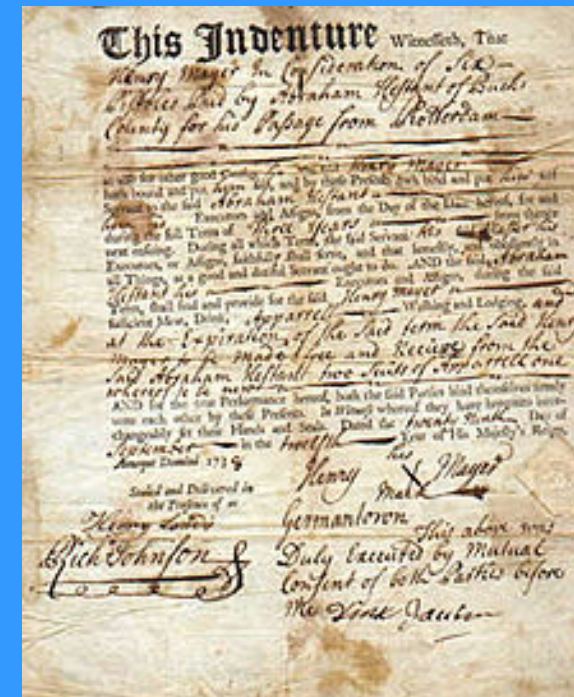

Du XVIème au XVIIIème siècle

- Essentiellement anglo-saxon
- Persécutions religieuses en Europe
 - Puritains
 - Virginie (Jamestown)
 - Massachusetts (Plymouth) Mayflower
- Indenture: contrat de domesticité à durée limitée qui paye le voyage (50 % des passages au XVIIème et XVIIIème siècle)
- Environ 1 million sur la période
- 1790 Act limited naturalization





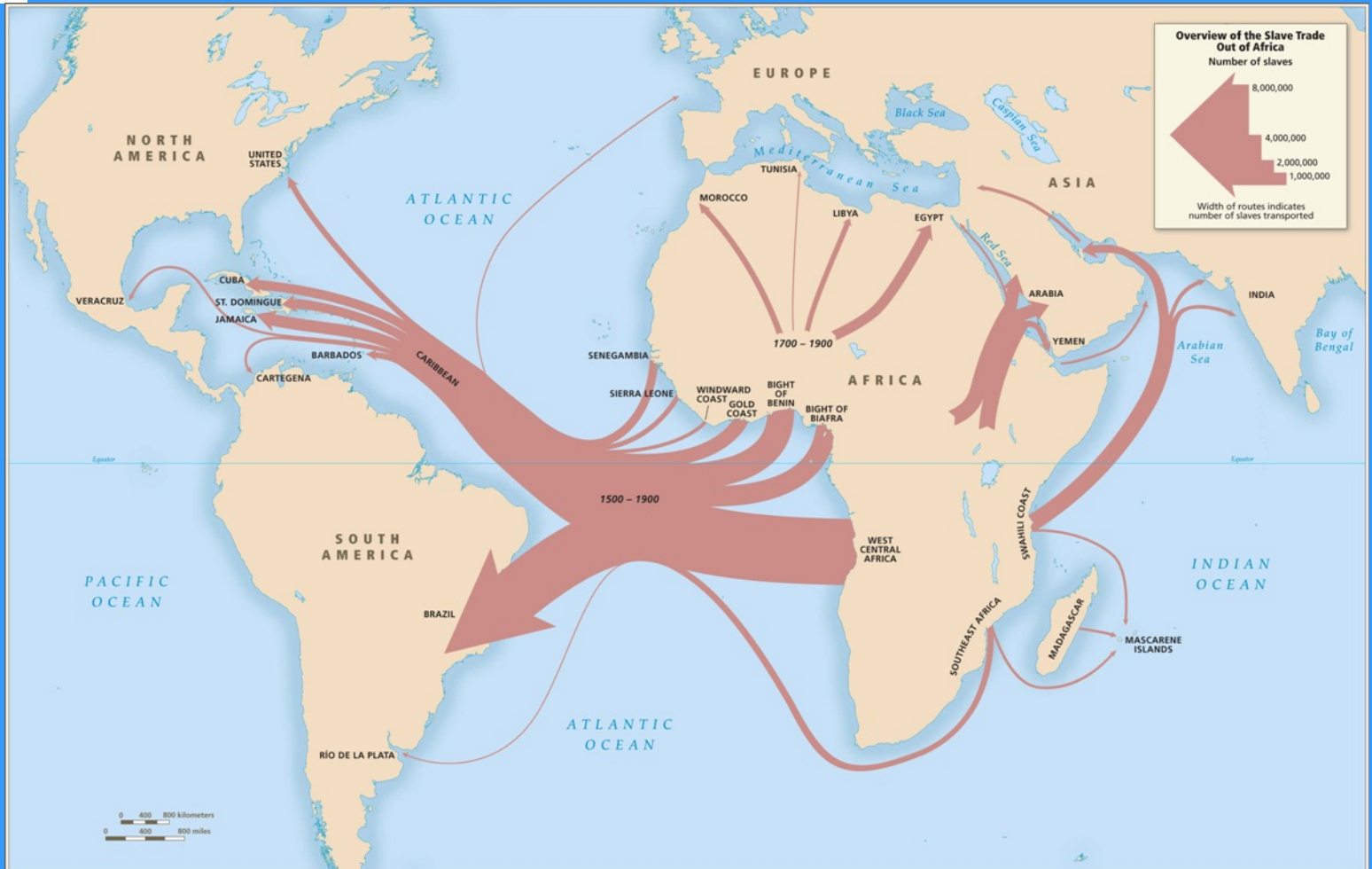
Du XVIème au XVIIIème siècle

- Esclavage
 - Passage progressif de l'indenture à l'esclavage
 - 1790: 700 000 esclaves noirs 19 % population
 - Immigration forcée liées aux besoins de l'agriculture vivrière
 - Forte mortalité durant le voyage et dans les plantations
 - Pas de perception négative avant le début du XIXème siècle

Evolution territoriale USA

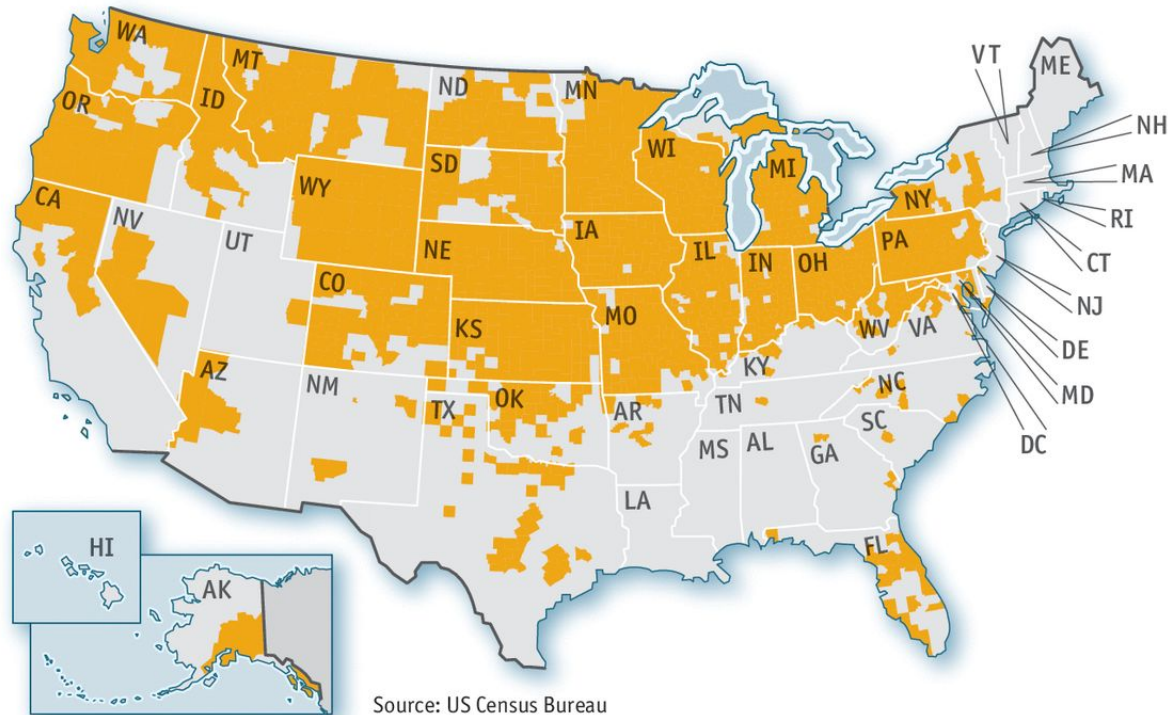

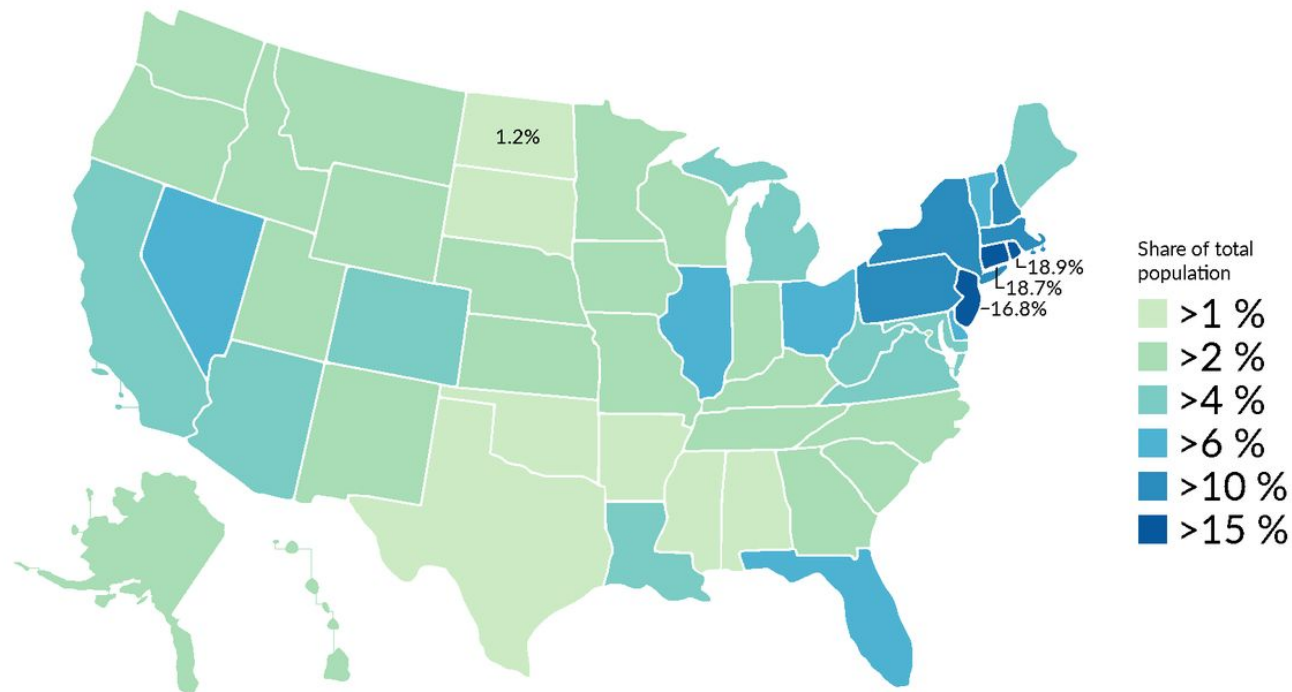

Americans of Italian Descent

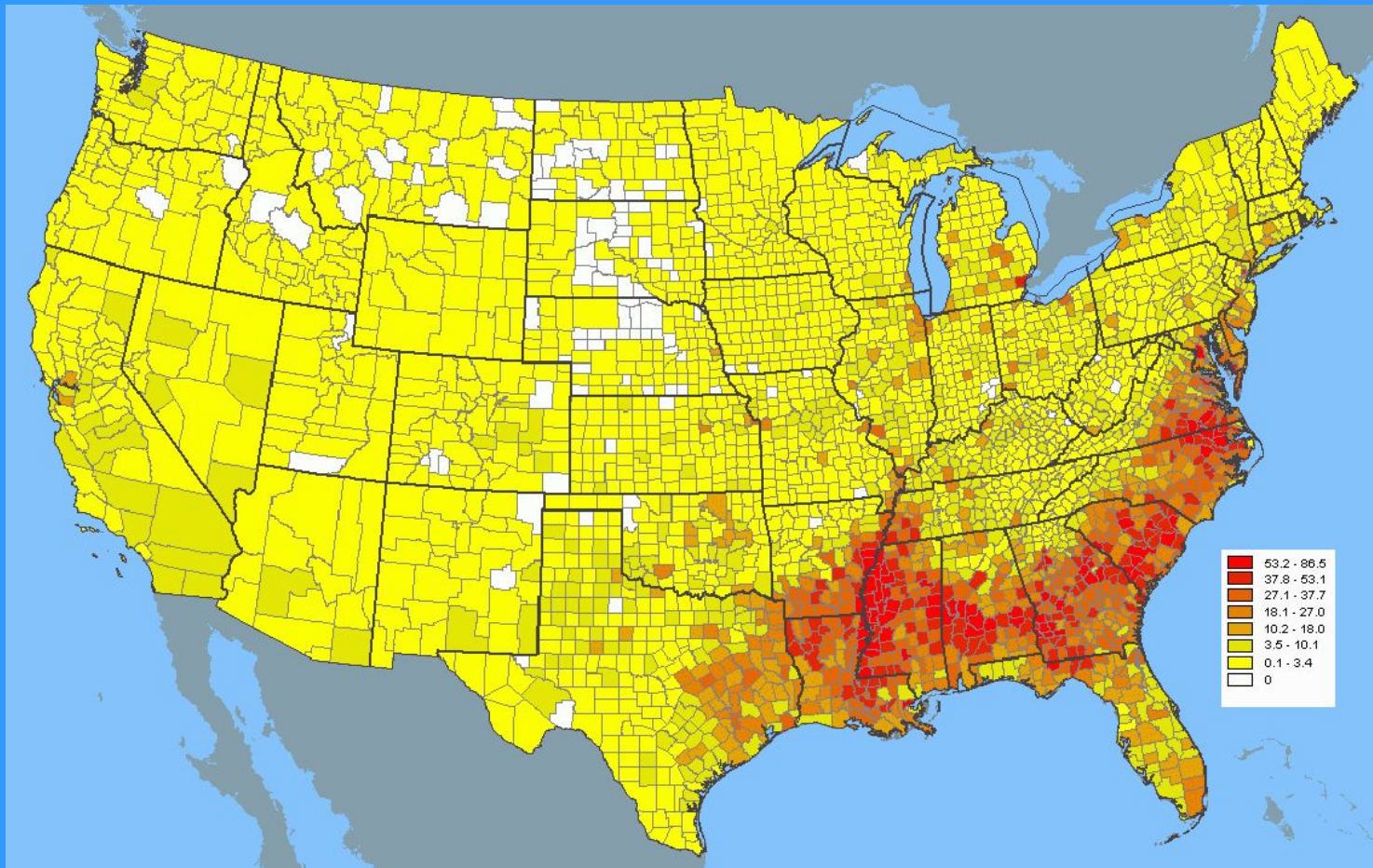

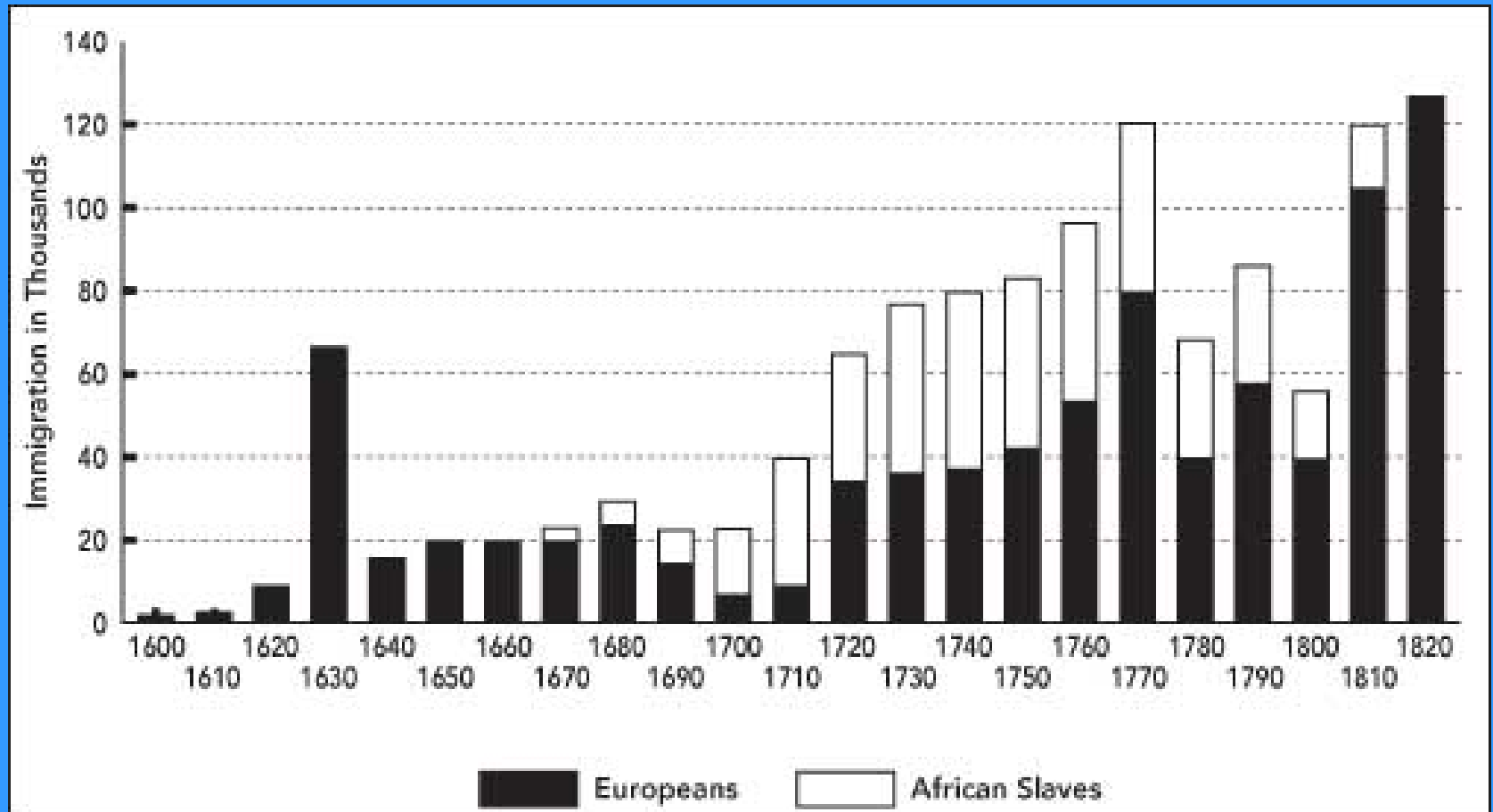

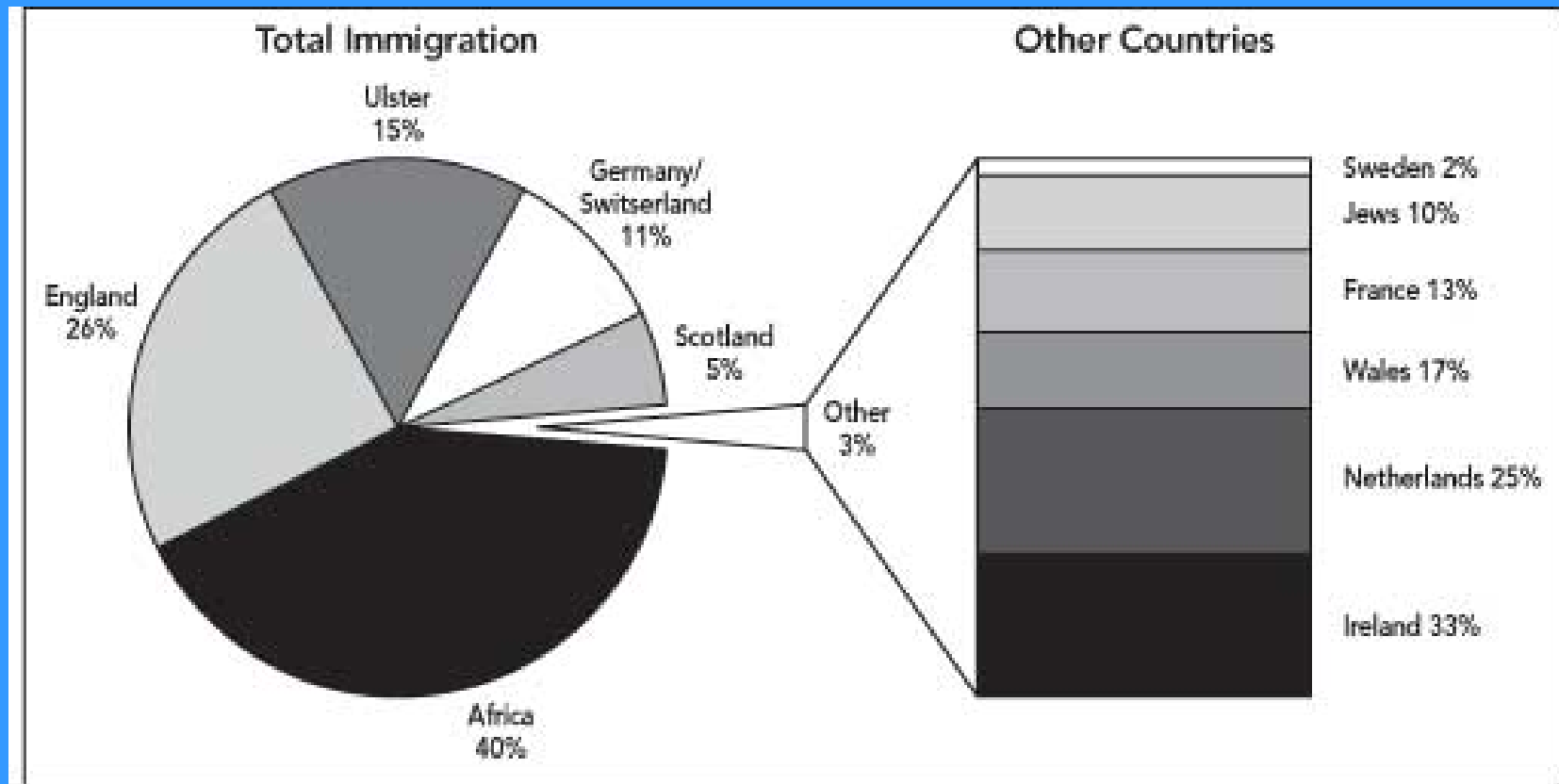

Le XIXème siècle

- Palier bas d'immigration jusqu'en 1820 (8000/an)
- Augmentation progressive du flux à partir du milieu du siècle
- Immigration chinoise (ruée vers l'or 1848-55)
- Immigration Europe centrale suite aux révolutions manquées (1849)
- L'immigration n'est vécue négativement que pour des motifs ethniques (chinois)



Le XIXème siècle

- Immigration irlandaise (famine de 1845-52)
- Puis espoir de meilleurs salaires et ruée vers l'Ouest

Le XIXème siècle

- Lois encadrant l'immigration
 - Page Act of 1875
 - Chinese Exclusion Act of 1882
 - Alien Contract Labor Law 1885
 - Immigration Act of 1891
- Jusqu'en 1892 c'est l'Etat qui prend en charge les immigrés: Fédéral depuis cette date (Ellis Island)

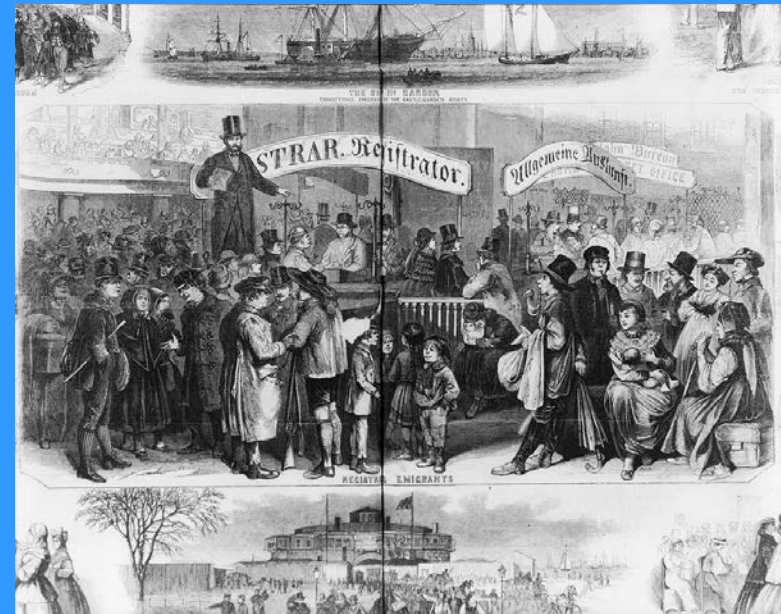


Ellis Island

- Ile initialement vouée à la protection militaire de Manhattan
- De 1855 à 1890 8 millions d'immigrants passent par Castle Garden (Etat de New York). Installation inadaptée.
- Le gouvernement fédéral décide de construire (en bois) un bâtiment adapté à l'accueil des immigrants
- 1892 Ouverture
- 1897 Incendie général
- 1900 Réouverture après reconstruction en dur
- 1954 Fermeture
- 1990 Réouverture comme musée

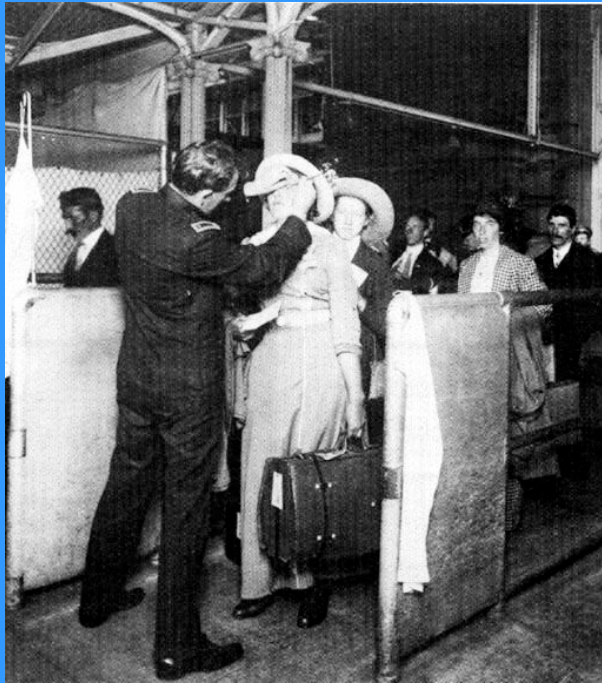

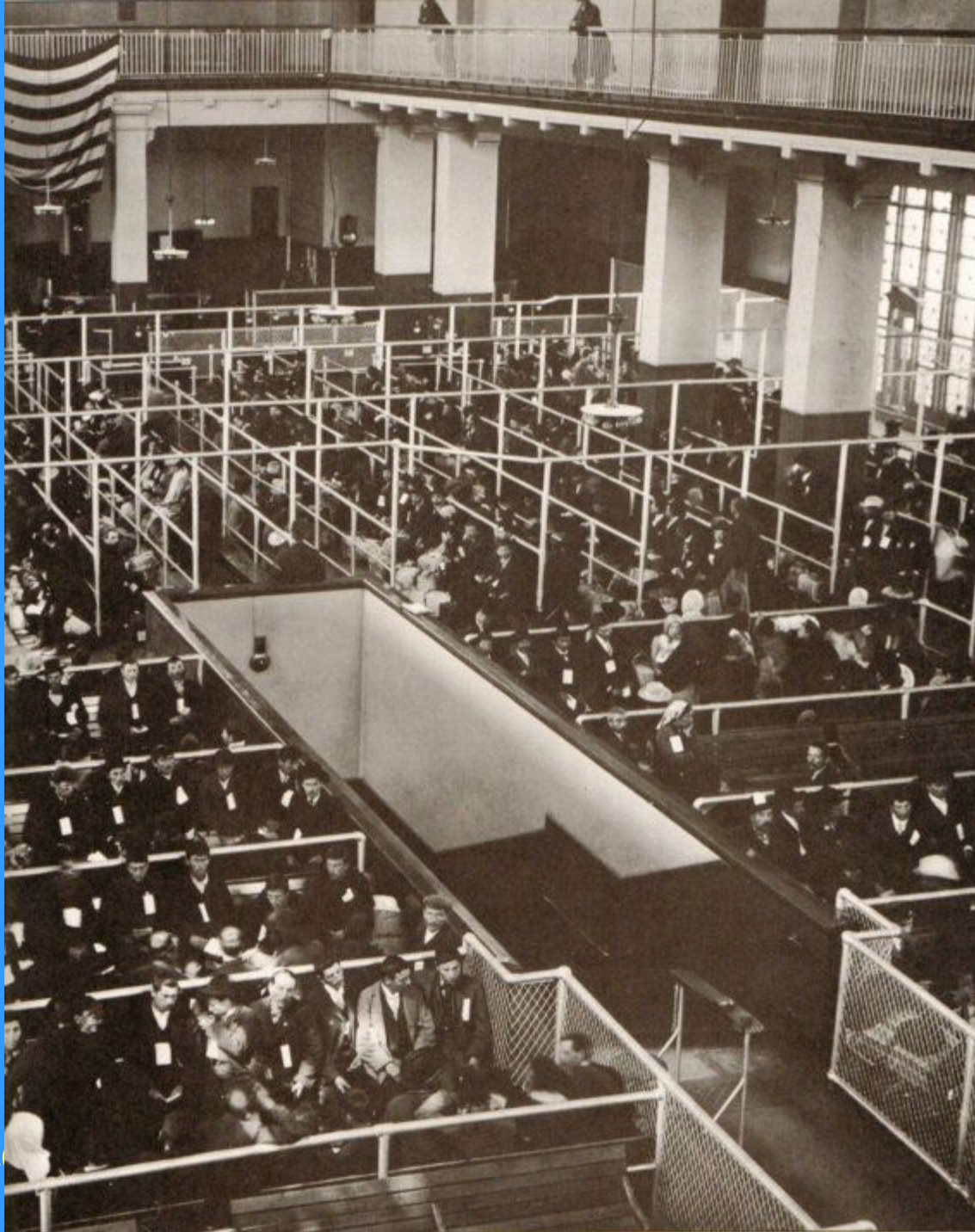

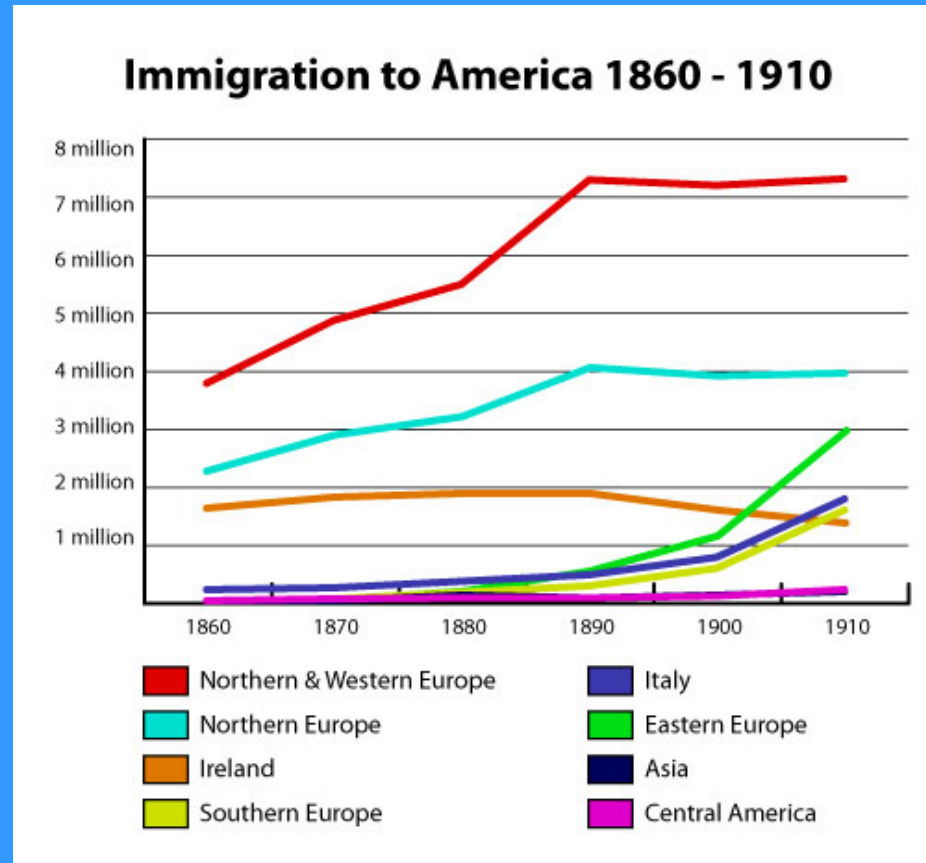


XXème siècle

- Débuts des retours forcés (Mexique principalement)

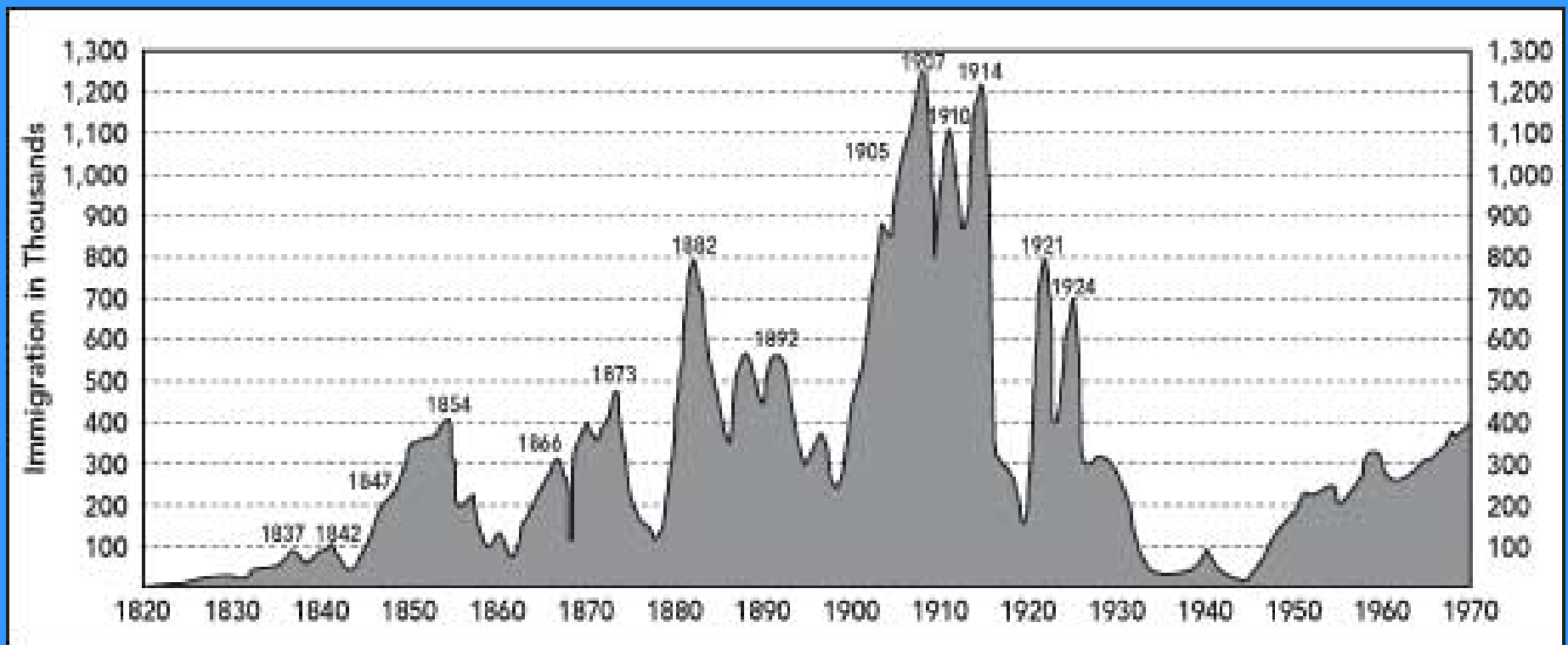

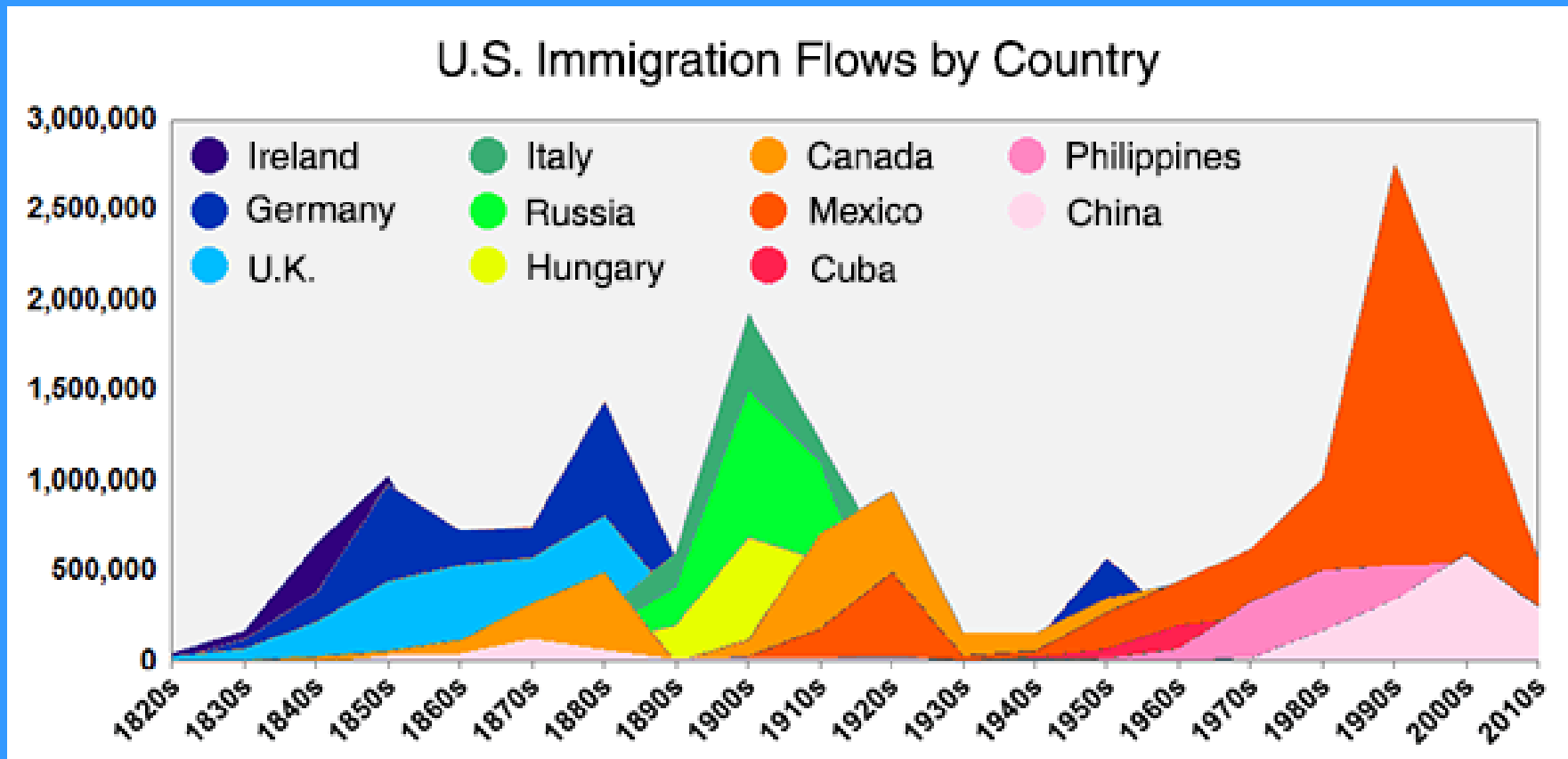

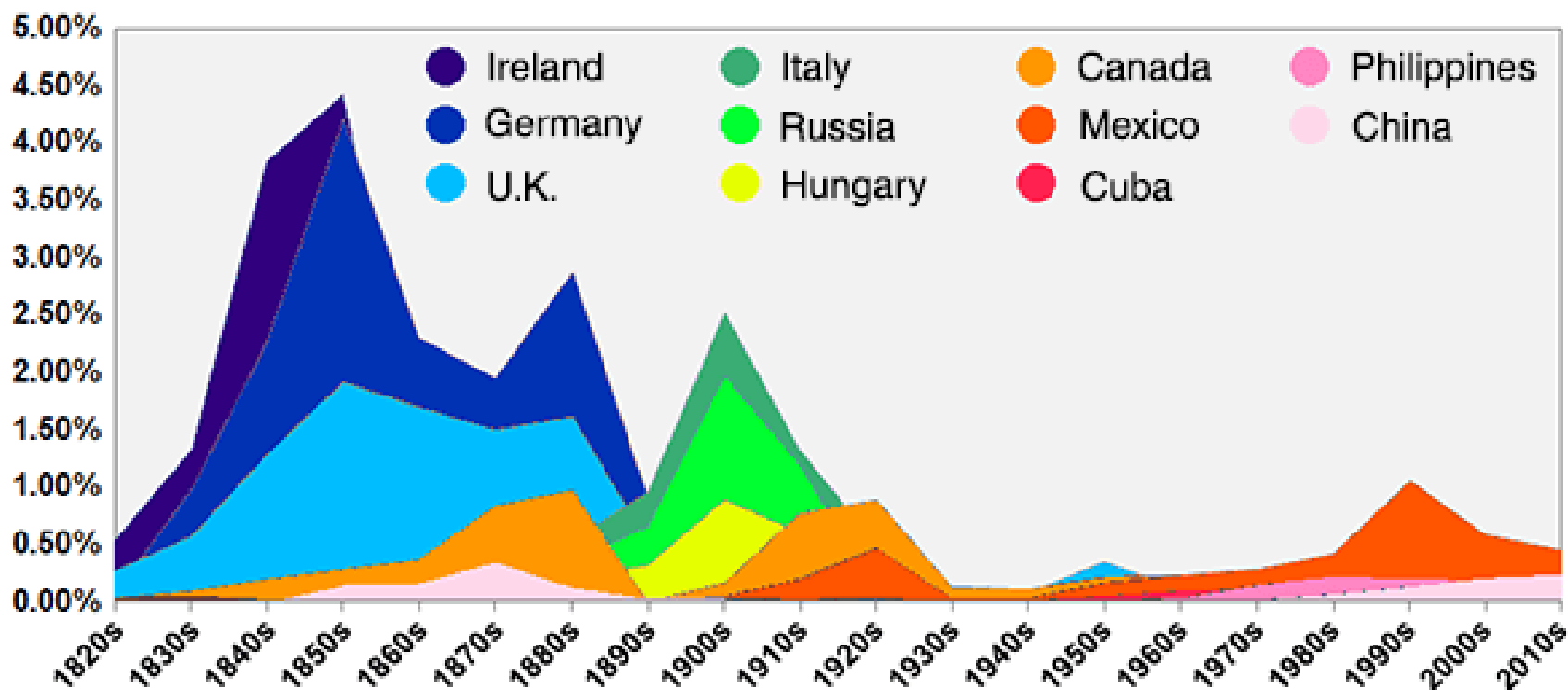


Statistique par pays (absolue)

U.S. Immigration Flows by Country (% of U.S. Population)

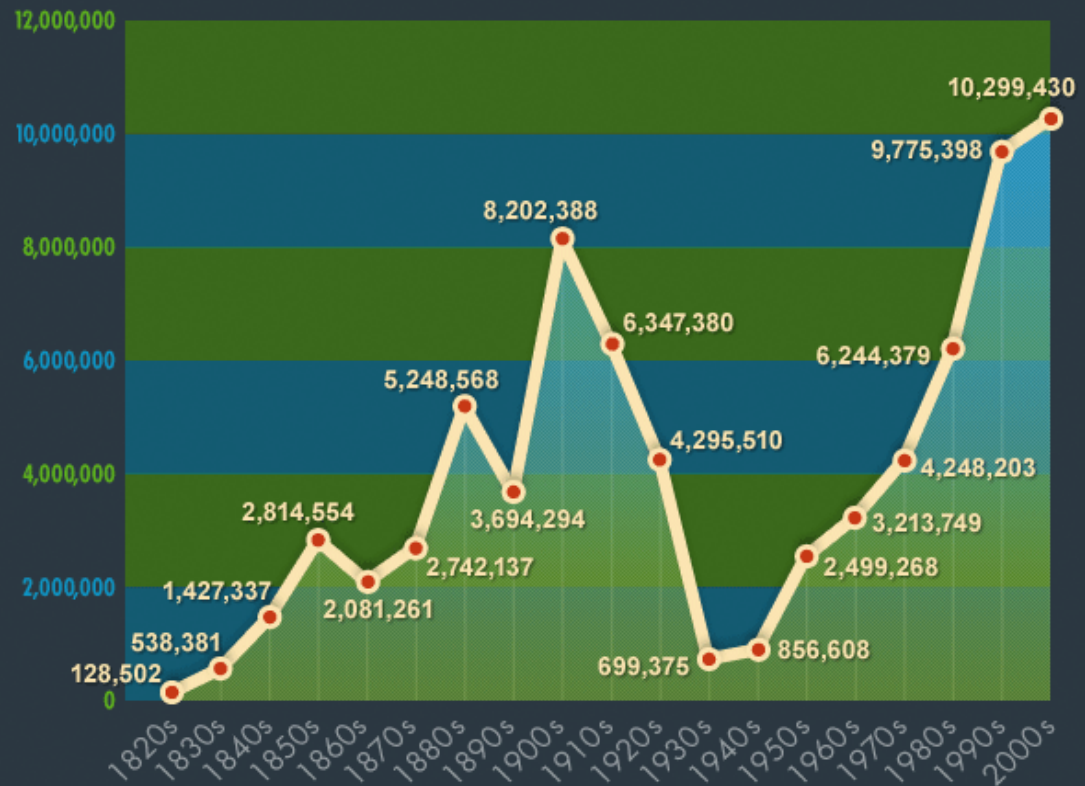

Total Immigrants by Decade

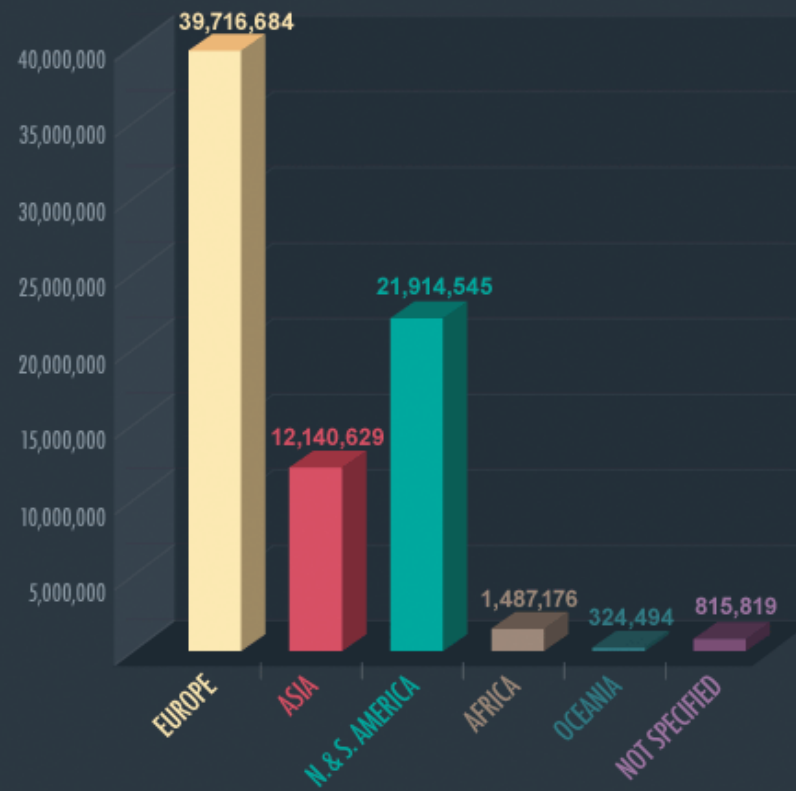
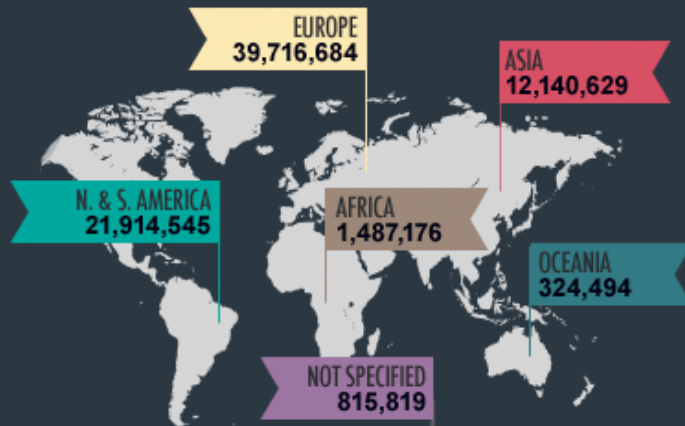
This chart shows, by decade, the number of legal immigrants who came to America from 1820 through 2009.

This chart and map show the number of legal immigrants who came to America from each region from 1820 through 2010.

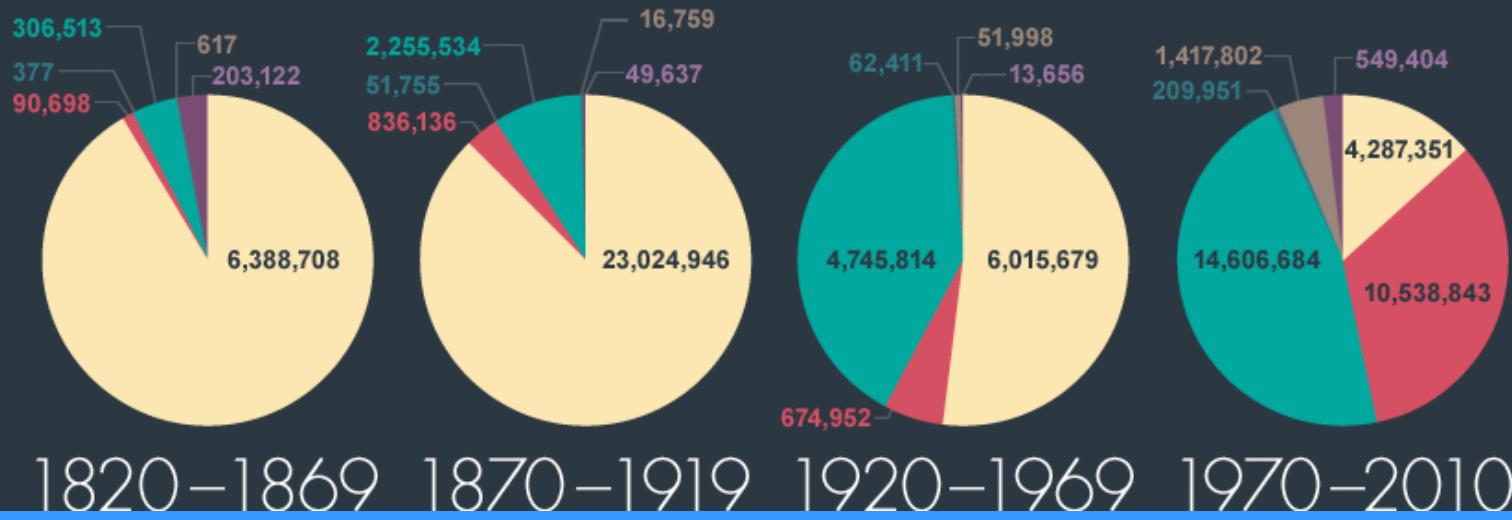




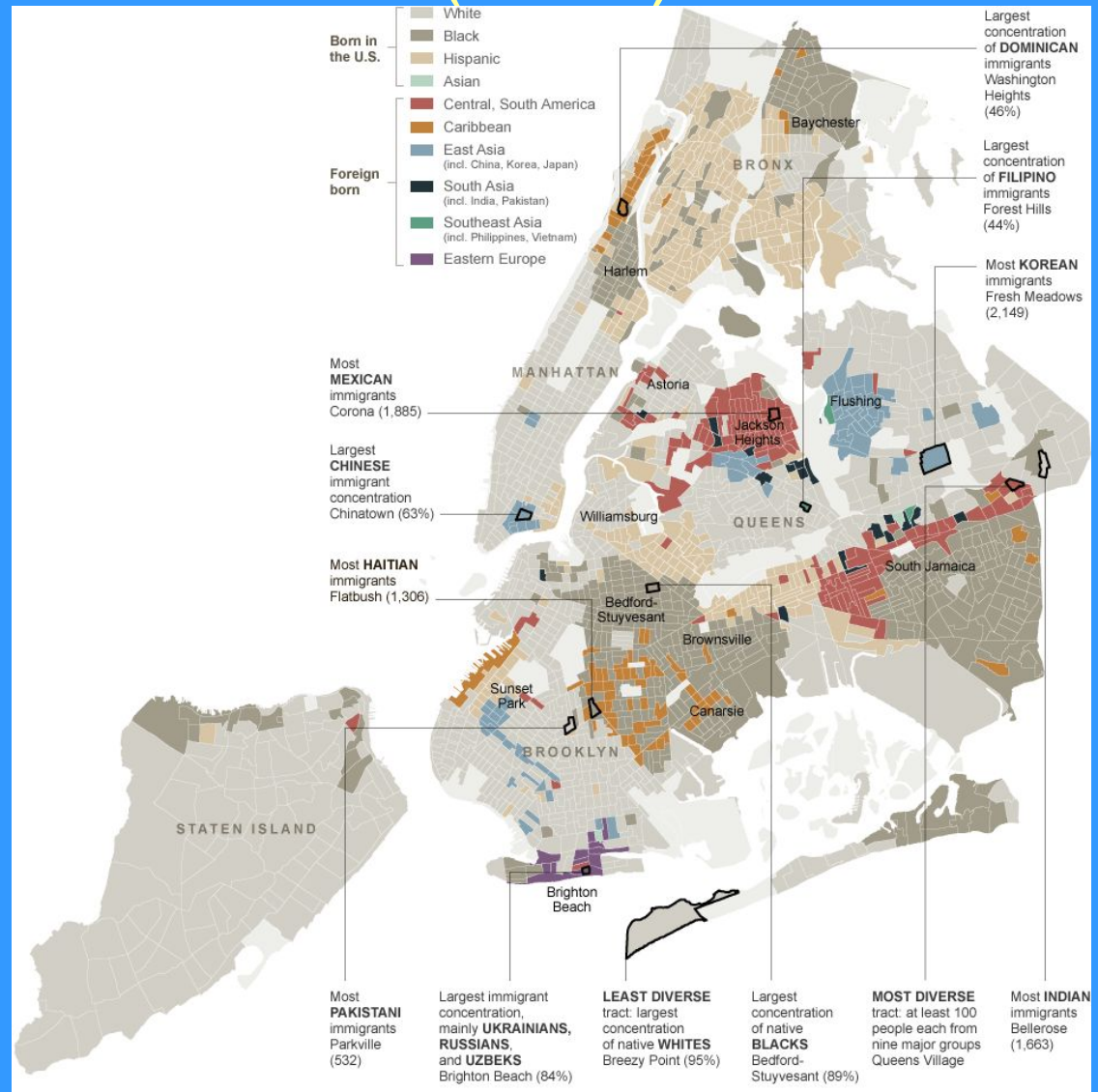

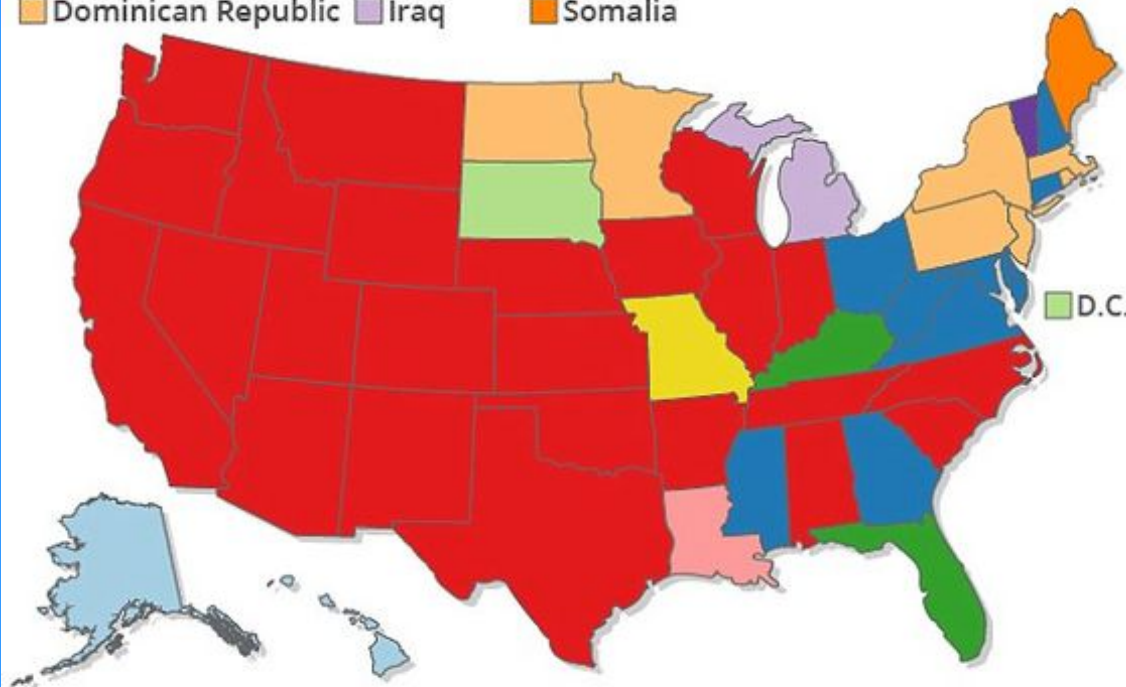

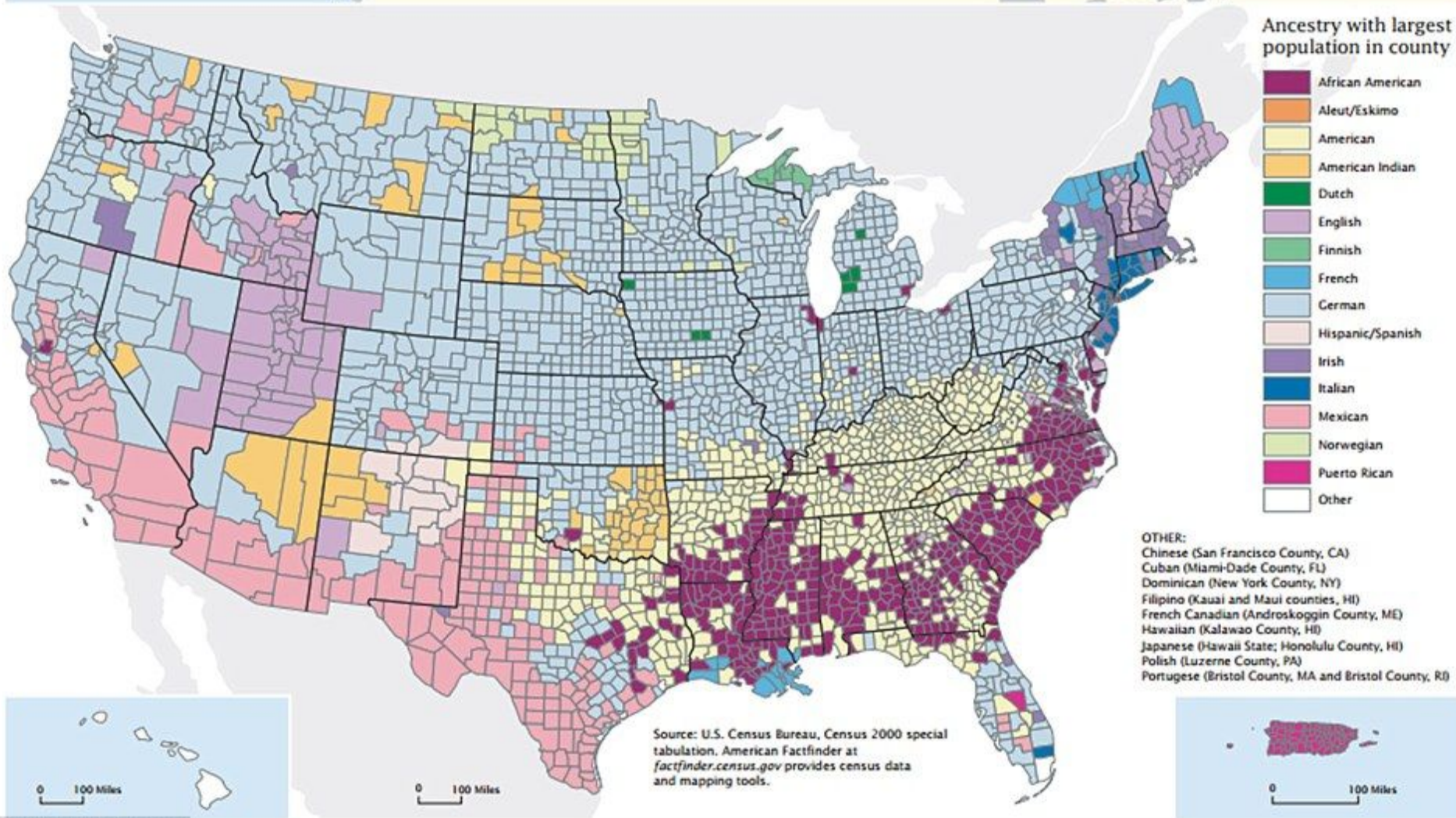
